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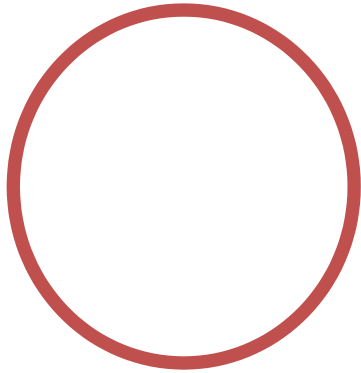

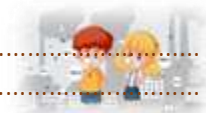

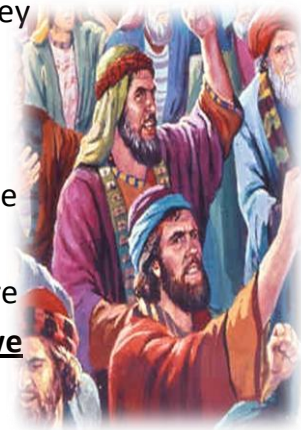

And do not be afraid of the people of the land, because we will devour them. Their protection is gone, but the LORD is with us. Do not be afraid of them.”

¹⁰ But the whole assembly talked about stoning them. Then the glory of the LORD appeared at the tent of meeting to all the Israelites.”

Muriel Hutchins – Karunanilayam



Introduction – Ms. Muriel Hutchins arrived from Great Britain as a missionary and started Karunanilayam in 1955 in Killinochchi. During the civil war in Sri Lanka, she was known as “Wellei Patti” or “white grandmother”. During the 30 years of conflict, she would not abandon her orphanage. Even though she had to use a wheel chair, and her hearing and eye-site was weakening, it never got in the way of her ministry. For 40 years she served in the North of Sri Lanka with orphans and the mentally challenged. She was a teacher by profession. She collected the money needed to run the orphanage by stitching pillow cases. In later years the children in the home took care of her. 130 female children resided in the orphanage and studied there. Karunanilayam serves as an orphanage, a pre-school and a home for mentally challenged females. The Tamil language is the majority spoken language at the home. Ms. Muriel a kindly lady, who devoted her life to her ministry. Currently Karunanilayam functions under the Church of Ceylon.

Prayer brings peace

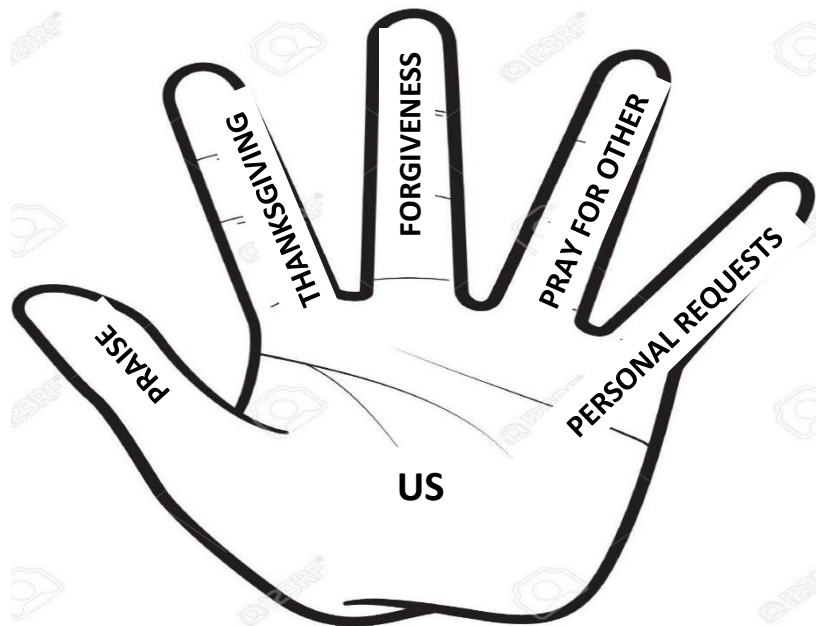


1. As Christians prayer is one of our 1st instruction.
